ORDER

Sanction of Rs.66.00 Lakh (Rupees Sixty Six Lakh) only is hereby accorded for release of funds under **CM Special Assistance (Mukhyamantri Swatantra Sahayata) 6th phase (Part-I) for the year 2024-25** in favour of BDO,Turekela for execution of 10 nos.of project under the scheme **CM Special Assistance (Mukhyamantri Swatantra Sahayata) Guidelines.**

While executing the project, the executing agency should follow the following points scrupulously and meticulously.

1. While executing the the project/s no deviation shall be made from the Plan & estimate prepared & administratively approved at your level.The funds should be utilized for the purpose for which it is sanctioned by the Govt.in P &c Deptt.Odisha and On no account diversion of funds from one project to another will be made without prior approval of the Govt.followed by the approval of collector..
2. The assets created under this scheme, should ordinarily belong to the Department concerned to which it belongs to and in no case it will be transferred to any other department.
3. All established Administratively & Financial procedure of Govt.of odisha and guidelines of Special Problem Funds should be followed for implementation of the sanctioned project/work.
4. The Executing Agency must ensure that funds so released are not to be utilised for repair and renovation works unless it is sanctioned for the project..
5. The project works should completed within Six months in all respect positively. In case of failure to complete the project within Six month, the reason there for shall be intimated to this office for issue of further instruction. In the event of lapses from the side of Govt.officials involved in supervision of the projects resulting in non-completion of the projects within the stipulated period, the fact may be intimated to this office for initiating suitable action against them. Stipulation of time limit for the work must be mentioned in the work order.
6. Construction of work can be taken up on a land on which construction work can be lawfully undertaken. It shall be strictly ensured that these works are not taken up on private lands.Land status report may be thoroughly verified and copies of the land documents be kept in the case record before execution of the projects. Before assurance of work orders for the projects/for repair/renovation/restoration/constriction of religious institutions, the executing agencies shall ensure that funds are not utilised for repair/construction by way of renovation, restoration or repair of religious institutions constructed unauthorisedly on public places. if the land of these religious projects are unauthorised public places, the work orders shall not be issued and this office may be intimated of the fact to move Govt.for cancellation of the projects.
7. For greater public awareness a plaque (Concrete/Metal) carrying the inscription "SPECIAL PROBLEM FUND WOKS" indicating the cost involved, the commencement, completion & the name of the sponsoring deptt(i.e Planning & Convergence Department,Govt.of Odisha)of the project may be prominently erected at the work site .
8. The photographs at three stages i.e. (before, during and completion of works) are to be kept in case record for verification
9. Any type of advance payment under the scheme is strictly prohibited.
10. As per the SPF guidelines any projects taken up under the scheme should be completed in all respects. The costs overrun of the projects due to delay in execution resulting in their non-responsibility of the staff concerned found liable for such lapses.
11. In case of any project sanctioned for execution with contribution from the beneficiary organisation/Public, the fund of beneficiary organisation shall be spent first and there after the Special problem fund.
12. Any problem in execution of the projects may be forthwith brought to the notice of this office for kind knowledge of Collector. In case of delay in execution/abandonment of the works.

halfway by the executants for a considerable period as would be viewed by you to worthwhile to cancel the work order due to above reasons. you shall issue notice to the executants to resume the work immediately. otherwise his/her work order shall be promptly cancelled and such cancellation order shall be served on him/her under proper acknowledgement and the work be executed through any other reliable executants capable 13. After completion of the project, the savings, if any shall be forthwith refunded to the CDO-Cum-EO, ZP Balangir.

14. The work must be completed within 6 months in all respect. Strict action will be taken against the executing agency if he fails to adhere to the time limit for completion of the work, stipulation of time limit for the work must be mentioned in the work order.

15. The quality of works shall be of prime importance. Sufficient measures shall be taken by you to guard against any low quality works. The loss if any accrued to the Govt.as regards low quality work need be recouped by way of recovery from the Security Deposits/Performance guarantee deposits of the contractor/executants.

16. Regular review at your level of the execution of the projects need be conducted by you to ensure timely completion and to find out any problem coming on way and to take up corrective measures thereafter.

17. No pro-rate, contingency and supervision charges shall be levied by you as the scheme prohibits them and those provisions are not kept in the plan and estimates.

18. A separate Assets Register shall be maintained by you at your level for future verification & audit purposes.

19. The amount meant for the project will be opened for test check by the A.G., Odisha and the District Administration.

20. In case it is not possible to execute any project and no expenditure is incurred within months from the date of issue of work order for the reasons not due to Government, the funds in question shall have to be diverted to some other projects as would be decided by the Government. Hence, if such a situation arises then the facts with reasons may be intimated to the undersigned for needful.

21. Monthly Progress Report (both Physical & financial) shall be furnished to the undersigned by 25th of every month in the prescribed pro-forma for review and updating of data in the website of Special Problem fund.

22. The Executing agencies should ensure that funds released are not utilised for Construction bt way of Renovation, restoration or repair of religious institutions under have been constructed unauthorisedly on Public places & there should not be duplication of projects.The details are given below:
